



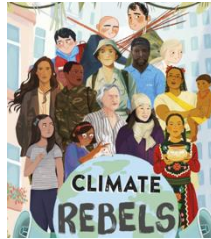
Our topic this half term in Year 6 is...

- Multiplying and dividing fractions



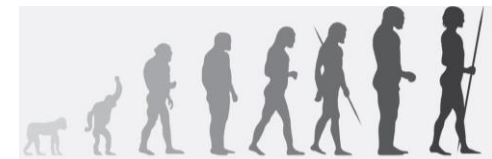
In **curriculum**, we will be...
